#### DID YOU KNOW?

The Steigerlied (also Steigermarsch or Glück auf, der Steiger kommt) is a German miner's folk song, which originated in the Erzgebirge and is now also widespread in other regions of Germany. The first evidence of the **Steigerlied** as such can be found in the description of a festive event held in Schneeberg in 1678 in honor of the Saxon Elector Johann Georg II. The theme of the **Steigerlied** is the miners' hope to return to the light of day and their families after the hard and dangerous work in the mine. Other sources say that the refrain "Glückauf!" conjures up good luck that the mountain will open up and allow the extraction of mineral resources. Several versions of this song can be found on YouTube. In fact, FC Erzgebirge Aue play it at their home games! Take a listen and you can get a feel of the heart of the Erzgebirge!
