DID YOU KNOW?

The term Weihnachtsmann is a very generic German term for Father Christmas, St. Nicholas, or Santa Claus. The German Weihnachtsmann is a fairly recent Christmas tradition having little if any religious or folkloric background. In fact, the secular Weihnachtsmann only dates back to around the mid-19th century. As early as 1835, Heinrich Hoffmann von Fallersleben wrote the words to "Morgen kommt der Weihnachtsmann" — still a popular German Christmas carol. The first image depicting a bearded Weihnachtsmann in a hooded, fur mantle was a woodcut by the Austrian painter Moritz von Schwind (1804-1871). Von Schwind's first 1825 drawing was entitled "Herr *Winter.*" A second woodcut series in 1847 bore the title "*Weihnachtsmann*" and even showed him carrying a Christmas tree, but still had little resemblance to the modern *Weihnachtsmann*. Over the years, the Weihnachtsmann became a rough mixture of St. Nicholas and Knecht Ruprecht (one of St. Nicholas' companions). A 1932 survey found that German children were split about evenly along regional lines between believing in either the Weihnachtsmann or the Christkind. But today a similar survey would show the Weihnachtsmann winning out in almost all of Germany - except for most Catholic areas.



OCCER NEWS

Last month was a month to cherish as a VE Soccer fan. We had several youth teams capture league titles (ICSL champions: U10 Boys D1 Bucks, U11 Girls D2 Falken, U9 Boys D1-82 Green, U17 Girls Elite Rage, and U12 Girls D5 Snipers), teams win trophies at various weekend tournaments, and most importantly, our Men's Majors team qualified for the 2024 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup.

To put this in perspective, Evan Vare first put on a Vereinigung Erzgebirge shirt as a 4-year-old playing in the Club's Mighty Mites program. On Sunday, Vare converted a decisive penalty kick surround by hundreds of Club members and fans to send the VE Majors team into the 2024 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup.

With the penalty kick victory over New Jersey Alliance FC, Vare and company became one of 11 amateur teams from across the country to qualify for the tournament through four rounds of local qualifying. The Majors last qualified in 2019 but never got a chance to play in the competition since it was postponed in both 2020 and 2021 due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

"It's an experience that I want to give my players," said Rob Oldfield, head coach of the Majors team. "We want to see VE get drawn with a big club. It gives my Club members something to get excited about. It gives the players on our youth teams something to dream about. They all want to be Majors someday. Those kids have role models they can watch every week. Players that started at the Club, went on to have successful college careers before coming back to play for the Majors."

Vare was just starting out his soccer career when the Majors last competed in the U.S. Open Cup in 2002. He went on to play at Lehigh Valley United, where he was a state and regional champion and national runner-up and with the Olympic Development Program before playing collegiately at Lafayette and Villanova.

On Sunday, Vare was the hero holding out his arms near the penalty spot as his teammates and dozens of VE youth soccer players ran onto the field to celebrate. Kevin Smolyn and Sean Peckham, who both played in Sunday's decisive Round Four game, played the better part of their youth careers at the Club before joining FC Delco and Christian Williams and Johnny Ciarlante also started as young kids. Other players on the team have come through their summer U-23 program or via other local youth soccer clubs and college programs.

Additionally, both our Majors and Reserves are alive in the USASA Amateur Cup. Those semifinal games will be played at Bryn Athyn College on December 3rd and the Majors play in the next round of the USASA Open Cup.

It's an exciting time to be a VE Soccer fan.
