DID YOU KNOW?

French fries migrated to the German-speaking countries during the 19th century. In Germany, they are usually known by the French words Pommes Frites, or only Pommes or Fritten (derived from the French words but pronounced as German words). Often served with ketchup or mayonnaise, they are popular as a side dish in restaurants, or as a street-food snack purchased at an Imbissstand (snack stand). Since the 1950s, Currywurst has become a widely popular dish that is commonly offered with fries. 
