DID YOU KNOW?

Lebkuchen are traditional German Christmas cookies, often compared to gingerbread, that are soft, spiced, and honey sweetened. They originated in medieval Germany, likely first made by monks, and are made with a dough that includes honey, nuts, candied fruit, and warming spices like cinnamon, cloves, and ginger. They are popular during the Christmas season and can be sold with or without a glaze or chocolate coating.

Stollen is a traditional German, enriched, yeasted fruit bread that is popular during the Christmas season. It is a dense, cake-like loaf filled with nuts, spices, and dried or candied fruits, and is characteristically coated with a generous layer of powdered sugar.


