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DID YOU KNOW?

Spargelzeit is Asparagus Time! If you've not eaten white asparagus German style yet, you must come taste it for yourself! Germans take their asparagus very seriously. In Germany asparagus is white. This is created by painstakingly mounding up the dirt as the spears grow so they don't get exposed to the sun. Asparagus is only allowed to be harvested in a very short time frame in Germany, usually from the third week of April until the third week of June. Germans eat a vast amount of asparagus in this time. And with good reason — it's delicious!

Every restaurant introduces a **Spargelkarte**, a special asparagus menu, that is only served for these short two months of the year. Asparagus soups, risottos, pizzas, salads, with Schnitzel or without, it's all there. The most common way to enjoy it is with plain boiled potatoes (Salzkartoffeln), cooked ham (Schinken), and melted butter or Hollandaise sauce. Asparagus season is amazing!!

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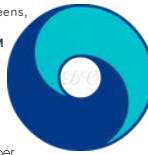
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CORNER KICK SOCCER NEWS

The soccer program has never been busier and with the completion of our new turf fields we are entering an exciting time in our history. Spring soccer is wrapping up with just a few spring league games left; however, we still have a busy summer in store with our adult summer Bundesliga, our U23s, the summer camp, and our Summer Splash tournament.

Our Majors and Reserves still have a few games remaining. Meanwhile our Over-30 and Over-50 men's teams advanced to the regional knockout rounds of the amateur cups and play their next games on June 7th at the Ukrainian Club. Both teams could advance to the national finals this summer.

We had two boys' teams crowned as State Cup Champions this month.
